Sweetener Users Welcome Progress Made in TPP Talks, Continue to Call for Expanding Sugar Market Access

Washington, DC (July 31, 2015) – The [Sweetener Users Association](#) (SUA) today released the following statement in response to the conclusion of the latest round of Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP) negotiations:

“We welcome news that negotiators have made progress to advance the TPP talks, and as they continue working, we urge U.S. negotiators to grant expanded market access for sugar imports from Australia and Canada.

“A comprehensive, market-opening TPP agreement should include significant access for sugar that is needed in our domestic market.”

On July 30, SUA sent a [letter](#) to U.S. Trade Representative Michael Froman, urging him to push for commercially meaningful liberalization of sugar trade between TPP member countries.
