Dear Congresswoman Foxx:

Thank you for your letter of March 31, 2020, cosigned by your colleagues, requesting that the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) take action to make additional sugar available, in the form needed by end-users, through increases in the tariff rate quotas (TRQ) for refined and raw sugar.

As you note, the U.S. government took action to reserve and shift 300,000 short tons raw value (tons) of sugar from Mexico into its refined sugar allocation: 100,000 tons in November 2019 and 200,000 tons in February 2020. In February we reallocated the shortfall in the U.S. World Trade Organization (WTO) raw sugar TRQ, which should add about 70,000 tons to the market.

More recently, on April 3, 2020, USDA took additional steps to address the need for more refined sugar by increasing the U.S.-WTO refined sugar TRQ by 200,000 tons. We also increased the U.S.-WTO raw sugar TRQ by 350,000 tons.

USDA will monitor the impact of these actions closely. We aim to ensure an adequate supply for the domestic market and will take further action, if necessary, to maintain a balanced market.
